Suitability Information - Servicing/Wheel Alignment Requirements

To ensure this service is suitable for your caravan or trailer, please note:

- Caravan wheel alignment is only suitable for caravans fitted with independent suspension.
- This service cannot be performed on caravans or trailers fitted with torsion, roller rocker, or leaf spring suspension.
- Caravan wheel alignment is **not suitable** for caravans or trailers fitted with **Method rims**, as the centre caps cannot be removed

If you're unsure whether your caravan or trailer meets these requirements, **please contact us prior to booking** and we'll be happy to assist.

OPTIONAL STAND-ALONE SERVICES

WHEEL BEARINGS ONLY SERVICE — Perfect for added peace of mind between long trips, or if you've recently purchased a second-hand caravan or trailer. Does not include a wheel alignment.

INCLUDES: Bearings check, remove, clean, repack and refit (we do not replace bearings for new as they are vehicle specific, and need to be pre-ordered). This service also includes a brake inspection and grease.

HELPFUL SAFETY & MAINTENANCE TIPS

- **Tyre Pressure:** Always refer to your tyre placard for the recommended tyre pressure.
- **Wheel Bearings:** Proper lubrication is crucial for wheel bearing longevity (high-quality grease).
- **Brakes:** Ensure brake lines are free from leaks and properly secured.
- **Electrical:** Use dielectric grease on all electrical connections to prevent corrosion.
- **Suspension:** Worn suspension components can significantly affect handling and stability.
- **Coupling:** Check the coupling's locking mechanism for wear and proper engagement.
- **Chassis:** Address any chassis issues immediately to prevent further damage.
- Regularly inspect your caravan or trailer and notify us of any changes or unusual findings

LOCATION REQUIREMENTS

To ensure your service can be completed safely and efficiently, please ensure the following requirements are met before making an appointment:

- **Safe Work Area:** The customer must advise that the service location is safe and suitable for mechanical work to be carried out.
- **Clear Access:** A minimum of **1 metre of clear working space** is required on both sides of the caravan.
- **Level Surface:** The caravan must be parked on **flat, level ground (concrete or bitument)** wherever possible.
- Soft ground/grass, gravel, steep driveways or uneven surfaces may prevent work from being completed safely.
- **Site Photos:** Please provide **photos of the service location** prior to your booking so we can assess suitability and safety.
- **Tow Vehicle Required:** If you have booked a service with a **wheel alignment**, a suitable towing vehicle must be present to move the caravan onto our portable turntables.
- **Adequate Access:** The service area must provide sufficient room for our service vehicle, tools and equipment to be positioned safely around the caravan.
- **Safe Environment:** The work area should be free from hazards including excessive traffic, obstructions, pets, children and other risks that could affect the safety of our technicians.
- **Right to Decline Service:** If the service location is deemed unsafe or unsuitable upon arrival, we reserve the right to postpone or cancel the service until a suitable location is available. Additional call-out fees may apply.
